Dreams are the language of the Spirit.

Dreams give your faith a target.

"I will climb up into my watchtower and I will wait... And I will look to see what the Lord will say. Then the LORD gave me this answer: "Write down what I reveal to you so you can read it with a glance." Habakkuk 2:1-2

1. Withdraw: Get alone with God.

"But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed." Luke 5:16

"I will climb up into my watchtower and I will wait" Habakkuk 2:1

2. Wait.

"Be still and know that I am God." Psalm 46:10

"Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in Him." Psalm 62:5

"And I will look to see what the Lord will say." Habakkuk 2:1

3. Read God's Word.

"Write down what I reveal to you so you can read it with a glance." Habakkuk 2:2

"Stop listening for a voice and start looking for a verse"

4. Review it.

What are you seeing now?

Takeaways:

- **Dreams are birthed in God's Presence.**

"So the king of Israel set out with the king of Judah and the king of Edom. After a roundabout march of seven days, the army had no more water for themselves or for the animals with them. "What!" Exclaimed the king of Israel. "Has the Lord called us three kings together only to hand us one to Moab?" But Jehosaphat asked, "Is there no prophet of the Lord here, that we may inquire of the Lord through him?... So the Elisha said, "As surely as the Lord Almighty lives, whom I serve, if I did not have respect for the presence of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, I would not look at you or even notice you... "But now bring me a harpist." While the harpist was playing, the hand of the LORD came upon Elisha."

- **Dreams are moved from inspiration to participation.**
